District Profile

Parsa District, a part of Province No. 2 in Terai plain, is one of the seventy-seven districts of Nepal. The district, with Birganj as its district headquarters, covers an area of 1,353 km² and has a population (2001) of 497,219.

Program

HURON team conducted training in Birgunj at Parsa district on 22nd July, 2017. The duration of training program was 7 hours (9am to 4pm). The training program was conducted by Human Rights Trainers, member and program officers.

Altogether, 70 participants from different background attended the program with an aim to have a better understanding of the Concept Fundamental Rights, International Laws and Treaties, Gentlemen's Agreement, Civil Rights, Good Governance, Federalism, Crisis Management and Sustainable Development Goals.

After the inaugural ceremony, the training was held. The training team consisted of Mr. Kalyan Pokhrel, HURON and Mr. Indra Prasad Aryal, President HURON.

There were total 55 participants where HURON members, Media Personnel, Security personnel (Nepal police and Armed Police Force), students, teachers etc. were attended. Out of 55 participants 14 were female and 41 were male.

The overall development goal of the one day educational training program was to train and educate members about Human Rights specifically our training agendas.
