District Profile

Dhangadhi is a sub metropolitan city in Far-Western Nepal. It is the Headquarter of Kailali District in the Seti zone. It has borders with Uttar Pradesh state, India in the south and it is also one of Transit to India for Tibetan Refugees, Godawari Municipality and Gauriganga Municipality in the north, Kailari Rural Municipality in the east and Kanchanpur District in the west. Dhangadhi is a sub-metropolis divided into 19 wards.

Program

HURON training team conducted training in Kailali of Dhangadi district on 3rd November, 2017. The opening ceremony was started around 8:00 am in the morning and concluded at 10 am. The opening ceremony was chaired by HURON President Mr. Indra Aryal and other guests were HURON General Secretary, Political Members, and Representatives from Security personnel, NGOs and Civil Society members

Training session began right after the opening ceremony. There were total 45 participants where HURON members, Media Personnel, Security personnel (Nepal police and Armed Police Force), students, teachers, NGO networks, politicians etc. were attended. Out of 45 participants 7 were female and 38 were male.

The training templates which were distributed covered Fundamental Rights of Nepal, Civil Rights, Good Governance, Gentlemen's Agreement, International laws and Regulations and Treaties, Federalism, Crisis Management and Sustainable Development Goals.
